

RIAM Graduate Library Membership Scheme

Scope and Purpose: The aim of this scheme is to enable RIAM graduates access to the library for borrowing purposes when they have graduated and are no longer registered for any study at this institution.

This is offered to students who have successfully completed a full-time course at the RIAM (Access, Diploma, BMus, BMusEd, MMus, DMus).

Conditions of membership Applicants must also be in good standing with the library (i.e. not having any unreturned overdue materials out, or any outstanding bills/fines). All such amounts must be cleared prior to considering an application for membership.

The standard rate of fines will apply for overdue items. Standard library regulations are applicable and will be enforced strictly. Please see the RIAM website for current library regulations:

Membership fee: the annual membership rate is €30.

Borrowing quota: 3 printed items (4 weeks, 5 renewals on each loan permitted) 1 recording (1 week, 2 renewals). Orchestral, Jazz and/or Wind band sets will not be available for loan.

The RIAM will be unable to provide Music Pal cards for access to other libraries, as Music Pal services are only available to current students of the RIAM.

Electronic resources: Access to electronic resources and RIAM computers is not available to members of this scheme. This is to ensure our license agreements with suppliers are not breached.

Geographical considerations: for practical reasons, it is necessary to restrict this to borrowers living in the island of Ireland. Borrowers will be required to return materials promptly when due or when requested to do so by the library, irrespective of where they are resident in Ireland.
